Tot 1	3-5 years of age	 Blowing bubbles through mouth and nose. Opening eyes underwater and retrieving a submerged object in less than 2 ft. of water. Assisted front and back float, front and back glide, and alternating arm and leg action. Changing direction while walking or paddling.
Tot 2	3-5 years of age	 Safe water entry by jumping or stepping in. Safely exit the water using the ladder or sides. Bobbing fully emerged. Opening eyes underwater and retrieving a submerged object in less than 2 ft. of water. Unassisted front and back glide. Assisted alternating arm and leg action on front and back. Treading water using arm and leg action in moderate to deep water.
Tot 3	3-5 years of age	 Enter deep water by jumping in. Submerge and retrieve an object in chest-deep water. Deep water floating on front and back. Diving from a seated or kneeling position. Tread water. Front and back glide 10 yards. Front crawl with rotary breathing, back crawl, and backstroke.
Level 1	6 years of age & older	 Blowing bubbles through mouth and nose. Opening eyes underwater and retrieving a submerged object in less than 2 ft. of water. Assisted front and back float, front and back glide, and alternating arm and leg action.
Level 2	6 years of age & older and completed level 1	 Enter deep water by jumping in. Exit water safely using ladder or sides. Bobbing fully submerged. Opening eyes underwater and retrieving a submerged object in greater than 2 ft. of water. Unassisted front and back glide, and alternating arm and leg action on front and back. Treading water using arm and leg action in moderate to deep water. Introduction to breaststroke and elementary backstroke.
Level 3	6 years of age & older and completed level 2	 Enter deep water by jumping in. Submerge and retrieve an object in chest deep water. Deep water floating on front and back. Diving from a seated or kneeling position. Tread water. Front and back glide using different kicks. Front crawl with rotary breathing, back crawl, and backstroke. Refine breaststroke and backstroke.
Level 4	6 years of age & older and completed level 3	 Standing dive. Swimming underwater. Front crawl for 25 yards. Back crawl, breaststroke, and butterfly for 15 yards. Swim on side using a scissor-like kick. Tread water for 1 minute. Refine butterfly and sidestroke.

Aquacize is a co-ed water exercise program for adults of all ages, in a friendly, energetic atmosphere. Swimming skills are not required. No music is used so the pace is relaxed. This low-impact, water exercise program will tone muscles of all parts of the body with less stress on muscles. Classes are one hour long. Drop-ins welcome.
